Review questions:

1- What is the difference between mass and weight of an object?

Mass is the amount of matter in an object . The measuring unit of mass can be gram , kilogram or milligram.

Weight is the gravity force acting on an object . The measuring unit of weight is Newton.

Example: If the mass of an object is 25 kilogram then the weight of this object is:

$$25 \times 10 = 250 \text{ N}$$

2- What metric units are used to measure mass?

The gram is the basic unit for measuring mass.

A milligram is 0.001 of a gram . it is used in small amounts such as vitamins and medicines .

A kilogram is equal to 1000 grams. It is useful in measuring the mass of large objects.

3- What is density?

Density is how much mass is in a certain volume of matter.

4- What happens if you mix 100 ml of oil with 100 ml of water? why?

The two liquids do not have the same mass. Water is denser than oil. So oil and water separates . water has more mass than oil . so the water sinks to the bottom of the glass. The oil floats on top of the water. The density of the water is greater than the density of the oil.
